

**Secondary Education (SEED) Program
Master's Electives and Required "Selectives"**

The M.Ed. degree requires the completion of two graduate-level courses (6 credits): SEED 675, "Research in Secondary Education" (which can only be taken only in the semester IMMEDIATELY preceding internship or ANY TIME after internship), and a content "selective" (specific to each subject area and only offered in the summer). These courses and other electives can be taken at any time except during internship. The "SEED Electives" listed below are pre-approved; "Other Electives" must be approved by a student's SEED advisor, and a "Program Elective Approval" or "Substitution Waiver Form" must be completed.
