

Each academic year, the College of Education and Human Development awards a limited number of fellowships from funds allocated by the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Recipients of CEHD fellowships, both new and continuing students, are selected primarily on the basis of academic merit. In making the awards, the Dean of the College of Education and Human Development and the Awards Committee consider all materials submitted for the student's admissions file, including undergraduate and graduate GPAs, references, standardized test scores (if taken), and honors and awards. Fellowship recipients must be admitted to a CEHD program and maintain full time status. Enrollment is monitored each semester.

Checks are distributed by the CEHD Business Office after the last schedule adjustment day in each semester.
