<p>EDRD 630 Advanced Literacy Foundations and Instruction, Birth to Middle Childhood Advanced study of literacy theory, research, and practice as it relates to younger learners. Addresses sociocultural, cognitive, linguistic, psychological, and developmental influences on children's literacy. Reading, writing, and oral communication are included.</p>	3	
<p>EDRD 631 Advanced Literacy Foundations and Instruction, Adolescence through Adulthood Advanced study of literacy theory, research, and practice as it relates to adolescents and adults. Addresses sociocultural, cognitive, linguistic, psychological, and developmental influences on literacy. Reading, writing, and oral communication are included.</p>	3	
<p>EDRD 632 Literacy Assessments and Intervention for Groups Literacy assessments and interventions for groups of learners. Study includes an exploration of assessment tools for both classrooms and large populations. (Corequisite: EDRD636)</p>	3	
<p>EDRD636 Supervised Practicum in Literacy with a Group of Learners (Must be taken concurrently with EDRD632) Class members will work with students in their own classrooms or in a specified field setting.</p>	1	
<p>EDRD 633 Literacy Assessments and Interventions for Individuals Literacy assessments and interventions for individuals. Includes diagnosis and remediation for learners who find reading and writing difficult. (Corequisite: EDRDD637)</p>	3	
<p>EDRD637 Supervised Practicum in Literacy with an Individual Learner (Must be taken concurrently with EDRD633) Class members will each work with <i>an individual student for 15 contact hours.</i></p>	2	
<p>EDRD 634 School Based Leadership in Literacy This course prepares the reading specialist as a school leader. Students expand their knowledge of literacy gained in the prerequisite courses and apply it to professional development work with teachers at their own school site.</p>	3	
<p>EDRD 635 School Based Inquiry in Literacy This course is the capstone of the literacy emphasis. The focus will be on research-based inquiry related to literacy in school settings. Major assignments include a review of the literature and a teacher inquiry project.</p>	3
