

## **Peter R. Barcher**

Peter Barcher is Associate Dean for Research in the College of Education and Human Development at George Mason University, where he also serves as Associate Vice President for Research.

Prior to joining George Mason, Dr. Barcher was at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, where he served as Associate Dean for Research and Program Development in the School of Business. Before coming to UW-Madison in 1993, Dr. Barcher spent nineteen years with the State University of New York, where he held both faculty and senior administrative positions. During this period he received several awards from the campus and the SUNY System administration for his leadership and entrepreneurship.

During his career Dr. Barcher has served as PI/PD on over forty sponsored projects which have supported research, faculty and program development, international programs, economic and institutional development and other activities.
